MARKET PRICES

LOCAL MARKET.

London, Tuesday, Nov. 7.—The market today was a dull and uninteresting one, as there was not a great deal of small stuff offered. There was a change in prices of any note, excepting for oats, which advanced from 25 to 30 per cwt. In other lines prices were about stationary.

Grain—Oats were higher in price, at \$1 to \$1.05 per cwt.

Hay and straw—Hay was in good demand and prices were higher, at \$7.75 to \$8.50 per ton, nearly all the loads sold at \$9 per ton. Straw was scarce today, there being only one load offered.

There were no changes in the prices of butter and eggs.

Potatoes sold mostly at 55c per bag; other vegetables steady, as quoted.

The 20 or so dressed hogs that were offered sold at \$5 to \$5.25 per cwt.

Poultry was in good demand; the market is easier and prices lower today; turkeys sold at 125c to 145c per lb., wholesale.

Butcher's Meats—Sales were slow and prices were inclined to be a shade easier, especially for lamb, which sold at 12c to 14c in 1905 and 10c to 12c in the carcass.
