**POLICE THINK DROWNED
MAN SOUGHT DEATH**

**Slavin Disappeared While He
Was Swimming in St.
Clair River.**

Port Huron, Mich., Aug. 30.—John Slavin, 37 years old, was drowned about 5 o'clock this afternoon on the river. He was swimming

at the mouth of Black River and was without a bathing suit, though this is

forbidden. He swam half way across the river, turned around and started back, then disappeared. Two body divers were recovered 20 minutes later and an inquest will be held tomorrow morning.

The police believe Slavin ended his life, but his relatives dispute this, saying that he was fond of swimming. He leaves his parents, two brothers M. J. and James Slavin, and a sister all living in Fort Huron, and a brother, Michael, who lives in Jackson.
