**BANDIT IS IDENTIFIED
BY MOTOR MECHANIC**

Louis Morel Recognized As Assistant of Robbers of Hochelaga Bank.

Montreal, June 12.—Desire Berthiaume, motor mechanic, identified Louis Morel this afternoon as the man whom he saw on the afternoon of April 1, after the Hochelaga Bank collection car had been riddled of \$142,288 and two men had been shot dead, help to start the car which was waiting for the bandits on Everett street.

Berthiaume picked Morel out of six men who are in the dock facing a murder charge in connection with the holdup.

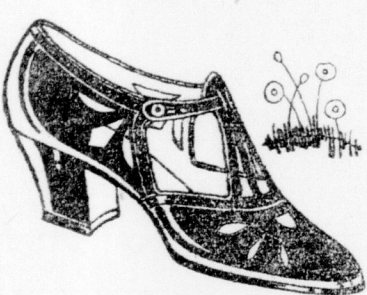
