



defaulter in his employ must be able to prove THAT THE MILITARY SERVICE PAPERS ISSUED BY THE REGISTRAR OR MILITARY AUTHORITIES TO THE EMPLOYEE IN QUES-TION WERE PRODUCED FOR HIS INSPEC-TION at the time when the employee was taken into his employment, and that it was reasonably estabhis employment, and that it was reasonably estab-lished to his satisfaction that the man was not in default under the Military Service Act. It should be clearly understood that the Canadian Registration Certificates given on June 22, 1918, at the time of general registration, in no way define the status of a man under the Military Service Act. man under the Military Service Act.


