ANDREWS AND WIFE CAUGHT

The Alleged Abortionists Arrested in Buffalo.

THEY WILL FIGHT EXTRADITION.

Murder Charge Recorded Against the Couple.

They Left Toronto On Thursday and Went Direct To Buffalo, Where They Put Up At The Buffalo House Under Pseudonyms.

Arrest Of His Wife Took Place In Buffalo Saturday Night On A Telegram From Arrest Co. - Nellie Lafontaine's Deposition.

Irwin Ransom Andrews alias "Doc" Andrews and his wife, Alice Andrews, charged with the murder of Lucy Lettice Denning of 444-1/2 Avenue, this city, were arrested at Buffalo Saturday night on a telegram from Chief of Police Graessli, and were remanded to jail.

The pair were taken into custody at the Buffalo Hotel, where Andrews had registered under the name of R. E. Hudson, his wife's maiden name.

Detective Burrows left for Buffalo yesterday with the necessary papers to bring the alleged abortionist back.

Andrews will fight extradition and has already engaged counsel.

THEIR FLIGHT AND CAPTURE.

Full Details of the Arrest of "Doc" and His Wife.

The police learned that when "Doc" Andrews and his wife left the "Infirmary" at 287 Shaw-street they proceeded to the Junction, where they put up at Haydon's Hotel and remained over Wednesday night.

They got breakfast at the hotel, and then a Grand Trunk train, paying their fare to Georgetown, where they bought their tickets for Buffalo, where they arrived on Thursday night.

The Buffalo police had meantime been notified that the professional abortionists and his wife had gone to the Hotel Haydon, Superintendent Chambers gave the case into the hands of Detectives Deane and Dempsey.

On Saturday night the pair were arrested at the Buffalo Hotel, Michigan and Carroll streets. At 7 o'clock on Saturday night they were taken to the Police Station and arrested.

"Who killed the officers that a charge of murder had been preferred, Andrews said, 'I would not have shot, but would have kept on going.'

He further said, while on the way to headquarters, that he could be sure always, that he had to miss once in a while. The inference is too plain.

In conversation with Chief of Detectives Cusack he inquired after a man named Jake Emmerick, who Cusack laughed, and replied that Emmerick was out of business now. Andrews seemed surprised and wanted to know who did the hanging now.

He was told of the electric chair, and it seems that Andrews was acquainted with Jake Emmerick, who acted as hangman at the time of the "Doc's" former residence in that city.

THE WIFE ALSO ARRESTED.

Except On This Charge, Andrews' Brother Operator Thomas J. Wiley that he had left some medicine at the Buffalo House, and that he needed it. Mr. Wiley went to the hotel for the medicine, and found a young woman who answered to the description of Andrews' wife. She was talking to the clerk at the door of the hotel entrance, and had her hat and shawl and an umbrella in her hand, apparently waiting to leave. He arrested her and took her to No. 1. She gave her name as Alice Andrews, and said that she was the man's wife.

MURDER ALONE EXTRADITABLE.

The Andrews Cannot Be Brought Back Except On This Charge.

The charge upon which the accused were arrested was the murder of Lucy Denning, and the extradition treaty not covering the charge of abortion. If extradited, Andrews and his wife will have to be tried on this charge. It is certain that they will make a desperate fight, as they have been charged with the murder of a woman.

In the first place he is known to be an old hand at this work, and has a good medical and scientific knowledge, and it is known to the authorities that several abortions have been committed in the Shaw-street house during the past year, and it can be proven that Lucy Denning was in his house, and was supposed to be a patient.

Nellie Lafontaine, sister of her brother-in-law's house yesterday and took the girl's deposition as to what happened in the house while she was there. Her evidence will establish the fact that Andrews was in the Shaw-street house, and that he was the man who was charged with the murder.

Andrews' PLEAS.

He Pleaded His Criminal Trade in Buffalo For Years.

Twenty years ago "Doc" Andrews worked his criminal operations in Buffalo. In 1878 "Doc" inhabited a little house in Clinton-street in that city. Neighbors complained that something was wrong, as they heard women's cries. Two headquarters detectives and Dr. William C. Phelps, at that time (1878) police surgeon, raided the house. Andrews told the visitors to inspect the whole house, but he played a clever and successful trick. Telling his wife to show the gentlemen upstairs, he went to the second floor, and there he was waiting for them. He was rather short and good-looking and a decided brute.

Andrews was arrested, and he was taken to the police station, where he was charged with the murder of Lucy Denning. He was remanded to jail, and his wife was also arrested.
