shall be allowed each Member. No Member shall speak a second time except for explanation. The reader of the paper shall have the privilege of a reply.

- 17. The President, or in his absence either of the Vice-Presidents, on the written requisition of any three Members, shall be empowered to call an extraordinary meeting of the Society.
- 18. It shall be competent for this Society, upon a vote of two-thirds of the Members present at any meeting, to expel any Member who has been adjudged guilty of any unprofessional conduct; due notice of at least fourteen days having been given to all Members and the accused party.

19. Order of Business:

- (1) Calling the meeting to order by the Chairman.
- (2) Reading of the Minutes of the previous meeting.
- (3) Proposal and Election of Members.
- (4) Exhibition of Pathological specimens.
- (5) Reading and discussion of Papers.
- (6) Cases in practice related by Members.
- (7) Announcement of subject of paper for next meeting.
- (8) Miscellaneous business.
