ARTICLE XII

The Government of Sudan shall guarantee Canadian personnel and their dependents the right to maintain bank accounts in foreign currency and export without any foreign exchange restrictions the money that they have imported into Sudan.

ARTICLE XIII

The Government of Sudan shall inform Canadian firms and Canadian personnel of the local laws and regulations which may concern them in the performance of their duties.

ARTICLE XIV

Differences which may arise in the application of the provisions of this Agreement or of any subsidiary arrangement shall be settled by means of negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Government of Sudan or in any other manner mutually agreed upon by the contracting parties.

ARTICLE XV

This Agreement shall enter into force upon the date of the Note from the Government of Sudan informing the accredited Canadian diplomatic mission that this Agreement has been approved in accordance with the provisions of the laws and the Constitution of the Democratic Republic of Sudan and shall remain in force until terminated by either party on six (6) months notice in writing. The responsibilities of the Government of Canada and the Government of Sudan with regard to projects being carried out by virtue of subsidiary arrangements entered into pursuant to Article II of this Agreement and begun prior to the receipt of the termination notice referred to above shall continue until completion of such projects as if this Agreement were in force for the whole duration of such projects.

ARTICLE XVI

This Agreement and the Annexes thereto may be amended by agreement of both Governments.
