- 2. Consultative Committees shall also observe the applicable Rules of Procedure of Conferences contained in Part I of the General Regulations.

CHAPTER 8

Conditions for Participation

1. (1) The International Consultative Committees shall have as members

a) as of right; Administrations of Members and Associate Members; have

b) upon request; such recognized private operating agencies as of the expressed a desire to have their experts participate in the work of Committees, subject to the procedure indicated below.

(2) The first request from a recognized private operating agency to take part in the work of a Consultative Committee shall be addressed to the Secret tary General who shall inform all the Members and Associate Members and the Director of the Consultation of the Director of the Consultative Committee concerned. A request from a private operating agency must be approved by the Administration of the Government recognizing it.
