

The said Bill was accordingly read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, and ordered for a third reading at the next sitting of the House.

The Bill No. 336, An Act respecting Marine and Aviation War Risks Insurance and Reinsurance Agreements, was considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Supply, and progress having been made and reported, the Committee obtained leave to sit again later this day.

The Bill No. 390, An Act respecting Currency, the Royal Canadian Mint and the Exchange Fund, was considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the following Bills, without any amendment:—

Bill No. 308, An Act to revise the capital structure of the Canadian National Railway Company and to provide for certain other financial matters.

Bill No. 333, An Act to amend The International Boundary Waters Treaty Act.
