Mr. Stanfield: Mr. Speaker, may I ask the Prime Minister (Mr. Trudeau) if that was a vote of confidence?

Mr. Bell: Then I rise on a question of privilege. I did wish to rise on a point of order, but I will rise on a question of privilege since I have been taken to task. There was no agreement on this subject, by the whips or by anyone, that we continue for the full hour. May I say that the parliamentary secretary has no right to reflect on the way in which any hon. member votes.
