Mr. MacDonald (Cardigan), seconded by Mr. Allmand, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-17, An Act to amend the Army Benevolent Fund Act, which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The text of the Message and Recommendation of the Administrator pursuant to Standing Order 62(2) in relation to the foregoing Bill is as follows:

His Excellency the Administrator recommends to the House of Commons a measure to amend the Army Benevolent Fund Act to grant in the manner prescribed to the Army Benevolent Fund Board authority in relation to funds that are similar to the Army Benevolent Fund, to establish a special account in the Consolidated Revenue Fund for each designated fund and provide for interest to be credited thereto semi-annually at a rate to be prescribed and, to provide for expenses of the Board consequential upon the assumption of the management of a fund.

Mr. Sharp for Mr. Buchanan, seconded by Mr. Drury, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-18, An Act to amend the Fire Losses Replacement Account Act, which

was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The text of the Message and Recommendation of the Administrator pursuant to Standing Order 62(2) in relation to the foregoing Bill is as follows:

His Excellency the Administrator recommends to the House of Commons a measure to amend the Fire Losses Replacement Account Act to extend its application to property, the right to the beneficial use or to the proceeds of which is appropriated to the Yukon Territory or to the Northwest Territories.

Mr. Lang, seconded by Mr. Whelan, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-19, An Act to provide for payments in respect of wheat produced and sold in Canada for human consumption in Canada, which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.
