(2) Sir Arthur Currie. 8th. Jan., 1923. Your name will at no time be used to assist in raising money or in any other manner which could possibly reflect in a disagreeable manner. What we wish is simply a statement to the effect that you approve and recommend our efforts in their educational and patriotic phases in so far as they apply to the Students Tours and the Battlefields and War Graves pilgrimages. Our general plan remains the same as before: to cater to the Canadian trade in a manner which no European or American agency has attempted to do.
