

RESOLUTION PASSED AT A MEETING OF THE FACULTY OF
LAW, MCGILL UNIVERSITY, NOVEMBER 11th, 1930.
(COPY)

WHEREAS the General Council of the Bar of the
Province of Quebec has asked the opinion of
this Faculty as to the desirability of amend-
ing the Bar Act so as

1) to require a university degree as a
prerequisite to admission to study law;

2) to increase the normal indenture per-
iod from four to five years;

3) to increase the indenture period of
students attending offices and a university
law course concurrently from three to four
years;

4) to defer the taking of the examination
for admission to practise law until the expiry
of the candidate's clerkship.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT

1) this Faculty is in entire sympathy with
