Dear Sir Arthur, Professor Babkin, of Dalhousie University, has, in accordance with your permission, visited us to look over the Department of Physiology with a view to taking on a position as Associate Professor. I should like to report the result of this visit. Dr. Babkin spent two days with us. He met members of the staff in Chemistry, Physiology and Pharmacology, as well as of the University Medical Clinic. They have all been very enthusiastic about the possibilities of getting Babkin for McGill. He and Professor Tait if he comes have agreed upon a policy by which he will help with the teaching to Dr. Tait's satisfaction, and will be engaged in independent research during the remainder of his working hours. His title, as agreed by Professor Tait, would be "Research Professor in Physiology." The funds therefor are adequate, or almost adequate, without any material increase in the Budget.
