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## THE LIBRARY INSTITUTE

This four weeks' course of instruction is planned to provide an introduction to Library Technique and to give those engaged in small libraries, or interested in library development, an idea of the elements of library routine and administration and at the same time, by means of illustrated lectures to arouse an interest in intelligently planned reading and to provide a geographical and historical background for selected subjects of reading.

It should be understood that the Institute does not cover as much ground as the usual summer course and that it is planned for those who have had a high school education but no experience of library work. On the other hand, it provides the training necessary for the efficient administration of a small library and a basis for further individual professional study.

Those who attend the lectures and satisfactorily complete the required work and pass the examinations will receive a certificate.
