Arrive at Pulo Condor — transactions there—depart from thence—pass the straits of Banca and Sunda—arrive at Cracatoa—Prince's Island—the Cape of Good Hope—Orkney Islands—and England.

On Wednesday January the 19th, we saw Pulo Sapota, distant about three or four leagues, and the next day, at one in the afternoon, descried Pulo Condor bearing W. S. W. about four leagues distant. Not being able to reach the harbour that night, we stood off and on till morning, and came to in the forenoon, not far from the spot where Dampier had anchored.
