ARTICLE I.

NAME AND OBJECTS.

- I. The name of this Society shall be "The Native Sons of British Columbia."
- 2. The objects of the Society are mutual benefit, mental improvement and social intercourse; to perpetuate and cherish in the minds of all native sons the memories of pioneer days; to unite all worthy sons of British Columbia in one harmonious body; to improve the condition of its members by encouragement in business and aiding them to obtain employment.

ARTICLE II.

MEMBERSHIP.

1. The membership of the Society shall be confined to male persons over the age of eighteen years, born in that part of Canada now known as the Province of British Columbia.
