do from my heart believe, that the profecution of this war will be attended with the ruin and downfall of this country; that, inftead of recovering North America, we fhall lofe all of which we are at prefent posseffed there, together with the West-Indies, and all the trade depending upon them; and that we might, by treaty, fecure what by an infatuated perfeverence in the war we are upon the brink of losing.
