¶ *Let these Sentences of Scripture be read before the Exhortation.*

O LORD, correct me, but with judgment; not in Thine anger, lest Thou bring me to nothing.
I will arise and go to my Father; and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against Heaven, and before Thee, and am no more worthy to be called Thy son.

¶ *The Hymn appointed to be used at Morning Prayer, instead of the Venite, &c., shall here also be used before the Proper Psalms.*

¶ *Proper Psalms, LXXXVI. and XCI.*

¶ *First Lesson, Jonah III.*

¶ *Second Lesson, Rom. II. to Verse 16.*

¶ *Collect for the Day.*

O LORD, raise up, we pray Thee, Thy power, and come amongst us, and with great might succor us; that we, who are justly punished for our offences, may be mercifully delivered by Thy goodness, for the glory of Thy name, through Jesus Christ our Savior, who liveth and reigneth with Thee and the Holy Ghost, ever one God, world without end. *Amen.*

¶ *Instead of the Prayers in Time of War and Tumults, and for all Conditions of Men, the three following shall be used:*

O LORD God Almighty, who orderest all things both in heaven and earth; look down, we beseech Thee, on us Thy unworthy servants, who turn to Thee in this our time of
