

# The Immediate Christianization of Japan :

PROSPECTS, PLANS, RESULTS.

A paper read at the Tokio Missionary Conference, on February 5th, 1884, by C. S. EBY, and published by request of the Conference, together with two Appendices containing the action of the joint meetings of the Tokio and Yokohama Conferences held February 14th and February 18th.

The above pamphlet contains a plan for united action in the Evangelization of Japan, and, although the proposals of the paper and the Conferences were found impracticable at present, the paper, etc., contains a statement of the problem which cannot but interest intensely all lovers of God's work in Japan.

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
