ONLY ONE KILLED

Sensational Report That Six Met Death at Helen Mine.

SAULT STE. MARIE, Ont., May 25.—Contrary to the sensational report circulated that six men were killed at the Helen Mine, by reason of an explosion, it transpires that the fatalities only numbered one, deceased being Louis Neime, aged 22, whose wife resides in the Soo. Neime met his death while drilling for a blast, a portion of earth and rock between the sixth and seventh level giving way and carrying him with it.
