their day in court to prove what value if any, their equity possessed, as set in Mr. Graham's opinion a complete answer to this argument was to be found in the legislation of 1914...

Mr. Graham said that the legislation was not intended to benefit Mackenzie and Mann but to benefit the Canadian Bank of Commerce and to make worthless securities in the possession of that bank valuable...
