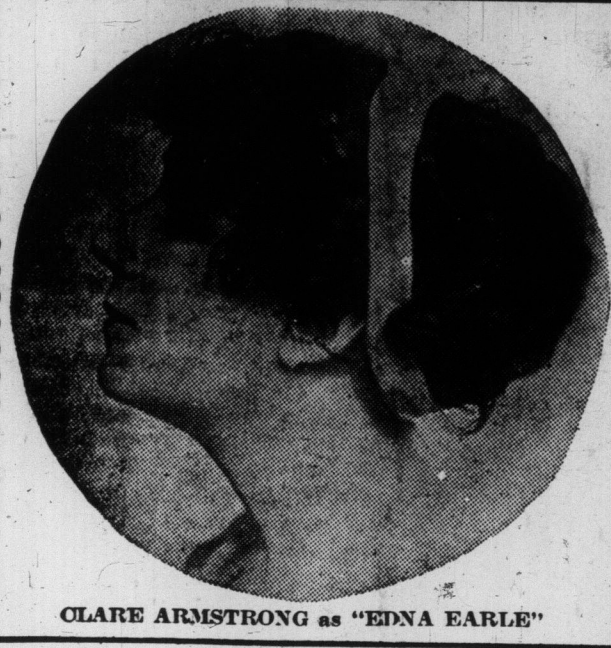

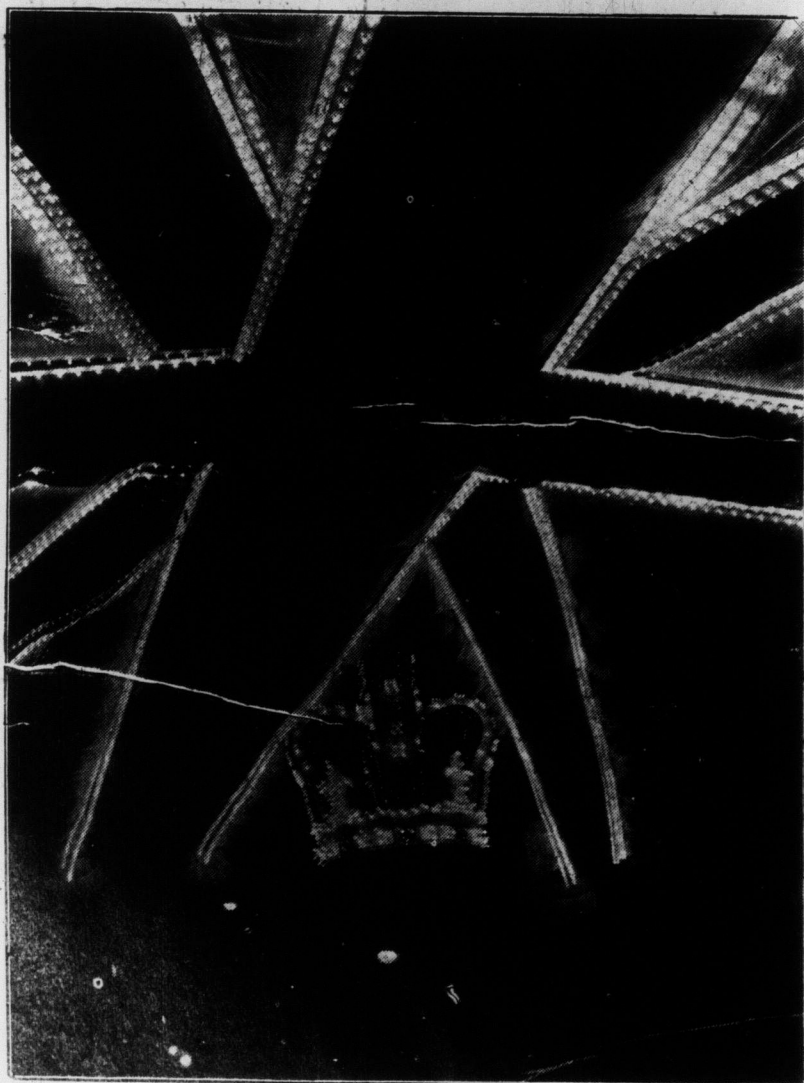

ST. ELMO.

"St. Elmo" for decades a novel that has wrung the hearts of romantic maidens, has brought the touch of remorse to the sated roue and has taught even the preacher his lesson of forgiveness. It has been done into a play by Willard Holcomb and will be presented at the Grand. Whatever may be said of the play taken from Mrs. Augusta Evans Wilson's brilliant novel, it will be admitted that it is built of excellent material. Dramatic in plot and atmosphere, the book has for all these years been the reservoir of inspiration for a strong play. The story as read by those in the time when the code duello was considered a necessity in every gentleman's education, was a strong satire against the futile slaughter which that practice effected. Like duelling, that part of the story has become obsolete, but that does not hinder the duelling scene in the first act from attaining the favor of the audience. The characters of "St. Elmo" and "Edna Earle" form the warp and woof of the whole story. The process that leads to their final union is indeed dramatic. She, the soft, spiritual type that puts purity of soul above all else, revolts against that part of her nature to which St. Elmo, the imperious, cynical duellist appeals. It is a fitting climax to the play that both soften their attitudes toward the other into a partial acceptance of each other's demands. The scenes are all laid in Tennessee. St. Elmo and Edna's first meeting being on the duelling ground near Chattanooga, just after he has killed Murray Hammond, a friend who betrayed him, according to the code. To her, then a crude country lass, unused to the vaunted chivalry of the southern aristocracy, this seemed practice effected. 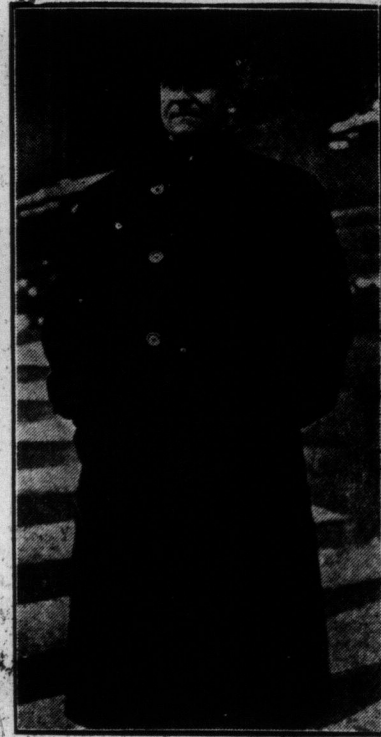
