Reserve at Loree, I beg to  
submit, that several Indians  
have already complained of the  
Whites making use indiscrimi-  
nately of two streets in the village,  
to have access to the Railway  
Station in rear of the Reserve,  
the same is also done by  
Visitors, Sundays and weekdays,  
who go to Chateau d'Eau,  
A grand Building, situated  
some 12 acres in rear of  
the Huron Village.

These Indians do not mean  
to complain of the Duke &  
Lake & John Railway Company,  
as the use of a street has  
been granted to the Compa-  
ny for express purposes,  
and there being no cir-  
culation of trains on the  
Sunday, but they strongly  
complain of the public  
making indiscriminate  
use
