PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that a Bill will be presented for enactment at the next session of the Provincial Legislature, entitled "An Act respecting public streets in the City of Saint John." The objects desired to be attained by this Bill are:

- (1) To authorize the City of Saint John in Common Council to make By-laws regulating the making, maintenance and closing of openings through the surface of public streets by the shutting owners, tenant, or other person.
- (2) To authorize the City of Saint John to impose charges for such use.
- (3) To provide for the recovery of such By-laws by fine, or imprisonment in default of payment of any such fine.
- (4) To relieve the City from liability for any injury caused by the making or maintenance of any such opening by reason of any permission granted therefor.
