## THE FAMINE IS STILL ON

Issued by the Canadian Committee, Save the Children Fund, Sir George Burn, Treasurer, Elgin Building, Ottawa, Ont.)  
The following editorial appeared in the Winnipeg Free Press under date of April 14, 1922:

"The efforts that the civilized world is making to mitigate in some slight measure the indescribable horrors of the Russian famine have to make headway against the perversities of fate. Something is always turning up to give the hard-hearted and the close-listed an excuse to keep the hands upon their pockets. One time it is some foolishly provocative speech by Trotsky, who would sooner let five million Russians die of hunger than forego an opportunity of biting his thumb at the hated western powers. Or it is some aggressive act by the Soviet government which cools outside sympathy. Among these untoward incidents must be placed a despatch, sent out from Moscow, which credits former Governor Goodrich of Indiana with having made the statement that 'the famine would be virtually ended by April 15.' It is difficult to account for the despatch upon any theory than that it is intended to accomplish some particular purpose; certain it is that the famine will not be over this month; it is, in fact, now at its height."

This is quite evident from the report recently made by Sir Benjamin Robertson to the British Russian Famine Relief Fund. Sir Benjamin was formerly chief commissioner of the Central Provinces of India, with a very considerable first-hand experience of famines. He was sent to Russia by a relief committee of which Lord Rannoch is chairman and spent most of the month of January in the famine district. Upon his return to London he was interviewed at length by The Times, and from this interview we quote these passages:

"Can you tell me something of the relief organizations?" "The American Relief administration are doing work for which I have the highest admiration. They are feeding approximately 2,000,000 children over the whole famine area in Russia, and the United States government has recently given \$20,000,000 (20,000,000) for the purchase of maize for providing food for the adults. That will probably bring in 350,000 tons of stuff. The British organizations are the Save the Children fund and the Friends of the Russian People. The former is working at Saratov and the latter at Buzuluk in the Samara province. The Save the Children fund is feeding 250,000 children, and the Friends of the Russian People are feeding 70,000 children and 30,000 adults. I have carefully examined both organizations, and found the work being most economically and efficiently run."

"The problem in Russia is that hitherto only the children have been fed, while the adults have been left to die except for their relief by the Soviet government. The Americans have realized this, and are now importing maize for the purpose of feeding the adults. I would especially urge that British relief should now concentrate on similarly providing relief for adults in the two areas where British organizations are working. These two areas contain over 1,000,000 adults, all of whom are in need of food. "It will depend entirely on the success of the spring sowing and the character of the season, however, whether the famine will be over then. By feeding as many as possible of these people up to the harvest we may do any immense amount of good, but on no account ought we to start feeding a person until the end of May. We should only take up to that time the people who are in need of food until August 31. Any programme of feeding must, therefore, be limited by
