



RAID JAIL, HANG NEGRO. Party of Mississippians Hang Alleged Slayer of Negro Woman.

Hattiesburg, Miss., March 28.-Held on a charge of killing a negro woman, Arthur Jennings, a negro, was taken from the county jail here by armed men. Later his body was found hanging in a Later his body was found hanging in a tree on the outskirts of the city. Jennings before submitting to arrest fired several shots at policemen and feeling against him has been bitter.

According to Deputy Jailer Herring, fifteen men came to the jail about 1.30 o'clock this morning, covered Jailer Mc-Kenzie with guns, ordered him to turn out the jail lights and, taking his keys, proceeded to the negro ward and informed Jennings they were "from Columbia and had come for him." They placed him in an automobile and quietly proceeded to the spot where his body was found.

SPENDING ONE-THIRD OF HER INCOME ON

NAVY CONSTRUCTION London, March 23.—Japan in 1927 will have a fleet equal to that of America and his will relegate the British navy to hird place, says a Tokio despatch to the Daily Express today.

The Tokio government, it is added, is pending one-third of the national income on the Japanese navy with the 927 programme calling for eight battle-hips and eight cruisers not more than light years old.

The Japanese navy, it is pointed out, was nearer that of the American than he German was to the Brittish in 1914, and Japan today is spending five times as nuch on her navy as Germany did in he pre-war days.
