Proceedings on Conviction before Sentence

After the Court has arrived at a Finding on all the charges against the accused and such Finding has been announced to the accused, the Prosecutor will tender to the President M.F.B. 355, together, when it is possible, with an M.F.M. 6.

These documents are read to the Court by the President, are marked "Y" and "Z", signed by the President and annexed to the proceedings.

Question to the accused.

Have you any statement to make concerning the documents which have just been read to you?

Answer.

I do not think I have done any harm to the Army when I was in the Army and given seven days! C.B.

Question to the accused.

Do you wish to address the Court?

Answer.

My Defending Officer will say something for me, sir. (for address by defending officer, see document marked "J")

The Sentence is then recorded on Page "A" of the proceedings and same is announced to the accused in open Court.

The President then completes and signs the "Warrant of Commitment", if any, which shall be transmitted forthwith to the Commanding Officer of the accused. He will also complete and sign in every case, the "Certificate of trial by Standing Court-Martial", and address same as directed by the regulations. The proceedings, with all documents, will be transmitted to the Judge Advocate General.
