

The Public Estimates

Public Works Outlined by the Administration in a Return Yesterday.

Liberal Appropriations to the Different Ridings—Restoring the Agent-General.

The estimates for the financial year ending June 30th, 1901, were submitted to the Legislature by the Minister of Finance...

RECEIPTS. The receipts are subdivided as follows:

Table of receipts including Dominion of Canada, annual payment of interest, Dominion of Canada, annual payment of subsidy to Government and Legislature, Dominion of Canada, annual payment of grant per capita...

EXPENDITURES. The estimated expenditure for the fiscal year ending June 30th is set out as follows:

Table of expenditures including Public Debt, Administration of Justice, Education, Public Works, Hospitals and Charities, Civil Government, and various other departments.

In the foregoing it will be noticed that provision is made for a mining recorder at Porcupine Lake at a salary of \$1,500.

Table of Justice department: The administration of justice is to be provided for as follows: Supreme and County Courts, Stipendiary Magistrates, Provincial Police, Juvenile Reformatory, Administrative Staff, Victoria Gaol, New Westminster Gaol, Nanaimo Gaol, Kamloops Gaol.

Table of Cowichan department: General repairs (including \$1,500 for Victoria-Nanaimo trunk road), Mount Sicker mines road, Alberni, General repairs, McCoyle Lake Outlet, Granite Creek Trail, Nanaimo-Alberni Road, Clayquot-Uchuelet Trail, Settlers' Road, Schooner Cove to Browning Pass, Bear River Trail, Trail from head of Uchuelet Arm to Long Beach, via Wreck Bay, Trail, Cape Scott to West Arm, Quatsino Sound, Trail, Coal Harbor to Hardy Bay, Bridge, Somas River.

Table of Rossland department: General repairs, Wagon Road, Westridge to Canyon City, Road to connect Phoenix with Summit Camp, Trail from head of road Phoenix to White's Camp, Repairs, Phoenix to Wellington Camp, Bridge, North Fork Kettle River, Kettle River, Columbia River, construction of road Phoenix to White's Camp, completion, 1,750.
