impartial, but men after all, are more
apt to listen to an argument which is urged
upon their attention by an attorney-general
than to one advanced by an unknown
junior.

How, then, the fact was, and they
had to make best of it, and a point in their
favor was that this man, although of a most
respectable nature, was comparatively
simple, and did not involve any great mass
of documentary evidence.
