EFFORTS TO LIFT THE MARKET FROM SLOUGH OF DEPRESSION FAILED

Few War Shares only stocks to respond—Gains recorded by few of the leaders wiped out before the close—Lives fall to new low record.

New York, Jan. 13.—Efforts to lift the market out of its recent slough of depression by a concerted drive against the increasing short interest in special stocks proved abortive in today's dull and professional market. A few of the war order shares made sharp recoveries from the low prices of yesterday, particularly Crucible Steel, which was helped by the company's favorable statement of earnings for December. Another encouraging development in that quarter was the report that the administration at Washington had registered its opposition to any legislation aimed at an embargo on exports of munitions. There were numerous substantial gains in high-priced specialties including United States Industrial Alcohol, common and preferred, American Coal Products and other issues of kindred calibre, but the movement in these stocks was plainly manipulative, and excited no general interest. Copper, for a time, displayed a better one on unconfirmed rumors of export orders at the high price of 24 1/2 cents. During the mid-session the rise gathered further impetus from a demand for high-class rails, including New York Central and some of the Pacifics, as well as Chesapeake &

New York, Jan. 13.—The bidding up of prices in a few of the industrials did not stimulate the general market and stocks developed a heavy tone in the afternoon. A little before the end of the session Mexican Petroleum and Amm Smelting and Refining broke sharply although nothing was received in regard to the Mexican situation. War order issues like Crucible Steel and Baldwin, which had been bid up on the shorts, also sold off rather easily, and the trading became much more active on the decline. A large amount of stock was received from England on the St. Paul, which arrived yesterday, and the offering of a portion of it for sale tended to depress the railroad list. Wall street losses have been reduced but little as a result of the recent selling movement, and the technical position of the market is little better than it was at the opening of the year.
