An Act to incorporate The Hamilton and Port Dover Railway Company.

W HEREAS the construction of a Railway connecting the Preamble. waters of Burlington Bay, at the City of Hamilton, with the waters of Lake Erie, at or near to Port Dover, must conduce greatly to the welfare of the inhabitants residing on the line of such Rail-5 way and in the surrounding country; And whereas

have prayed to be incorporated with the powers requisite for making Certain per-10 and maintaining such Railway; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That

15 together with such person or persons, Corporations and Municipalities as shall, under the provisions of this Act, become Shareholders in such Company, as is hereinafter mentioned, shall be and are hereby ordained, constituted and declared to be a body corporate
20 and politic, in fact, by and under the name and style of The Corporate Hamilton and Port Dover Railway Company.

II. And be it enacted, That the several Clauses of "The Railway Certainclauses "Clauses Consolidation Act," with respect to the first, second, third of 14 & 15 and fourth Clauses thereof, and also the several Clauses of the said incorporated 25 Act with respect to "Interpretation," "Incorporation," "Powers," with this Act.
