BILL.

An Act for the granting of certain Lots in the Town of Bytown to The Bytown and Prescott Railway Company.

THEREAS Lots numbers four, five and six on the west side Preamble of Dalhousie street, ten, eleven, twelve, and thirteen on the north side of Bolton street, and ten, eleven, twelve and thirteen, on the south side of Boteler stree ton Lot Letter O, in the Town of Bytown were reserved by Order of Council for the purpose of a Market site: And whereas the said Lots are unsuitable for that purpose, and the Municipal authorities of the Town of Bytown have made other provision for markets, and have expressed their concurrence in the said Lots being granted to The Bytown and Prescott Railway Company; And whereas the said Railway Company require the said Lots for ground for the Depôt at Bytown, and have petitioned for a grant thereof; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,
