Women's movemen around the world enjoyed va ing degrees of success mixed w failure this past year.

In Spain, the Ministry Culture has formed a commit on women's rights and is draw up laws for submission to Parl ment calling for, among oth things, economic equality greater protection against ran

Activists in the wome movement feel cheated Spain's new constitution, whi makes no reference to aborti day care or simple incompatib ty as grounds for uncontest divorce. Some women are a upset by the constitution's failu to change the country's ri custody law, which g husbands the absolute right custody of children in cases marital breakup. The consti tion does provide for legalizati of contraceptives, although doctor's prescription is necessary.

The biggest problem faci Spanish women, however, is attitude and social fabric of macho-style country. Voic the prevailing attitude, one m told an American corresp dent, "Our women are flying coop. And did you ever tryto a bunch of chickens back i guess it's all part of democracy thing. You give the the vote, and the first thing know they want freedom."

The study found uned training is given to women f childhood on and that occupy high-paying position Israeli wom Generally, salaries are only 60% of men. The study recommen a law guaranteeing equal opp tunity for men and women prohibiting discrimination salaries, job availability promotion.
