The Provincial Junior A North York Rangers will bear a striking resemblance to last season's Streetsville Derbys.

Tom Barrett, the man who brought five consecutive Central Ontario junior B titles and an all-Ontario championship to Streetsville, signed on Sunday as coach and general manager of the Rangers. North York was recently purchased by a Streetsville group from former owner Manny Farkas.

Barrett will team up with former Derby assistant general manager Rusty Evans who has taken on the same responsibilities with the Rangers.

"I decided to go with the team for three reasons," said Barrett. "One of them is that the group consists of friends of mine. That should make it a lot easier."

The second reason is that it ties in well with my job which is very important to me and the third reason is that I didn't want to sit out a year.

Barrett admits he had offers to coach other clubs but wouldn't say which ones they were.

"We're just moving the club (Derbys) 35 miles east," said Barrett.

Barrett hasn't had a chance to see his lineup but he isn't afraid of the challenge of Provincial Junior A hockey.

"It's still the same game," he said. "We'll be competitive, you can bet on that."

The club will lose a lot of players to age and scholarships which means Barrett has his work cut out for him before training camp begins Aug. 23 and former Streetsville Derbys could be in the plan.

"We'll send them letters," he said. "From there, it's their decision."

Rangers' president Doug McIntyre was

elated by Barrett's decision. "Tom Barrett's teams have always been filled with skill," he said. "His record speaks for itself."

Barrett originally joined the group as an advisor in charge of hiring a coach. He quit the Derbys last year after coaching his fifth straight league-winning team.

The Rangers, under former coach Bill White, made it to the Centennial Cup finals last year where they lost to the Red Deer Rustlers.
