Leeds (Continued)

July 19th

W.F.Summerhayes saw President Omer Brown and ex President
Alexander Stevens at Delta, and had a long interview. They
are keen to do the work, particularly if Hon.George P.

and Brockville united. They undertake to look after all
the lists in Leeds Riding except Gananoque and the Front

E.J.Pollard Editor of "The Express" Madole is talked of as candidate again for the Provincial for Lennox. H.B.Sherwood is spoken of to some extent as prospective candidate for the Dominion for Lennos and Addington None of the lists are yet posted up, but they promise to have them fully revised They are having some negotiations with Joseph Haycock at Glenora as to organizing the Riding this year and next year for which he would be paid.

W.F. Summerhayes also met Dr.J.P. Vrooman E.J.Pollard of the Napanee Express is very active workers, also acts as assistant secretary of the Association.F.F. Miller had met with an accident and was not seen. Dr.J.P. Vrooman of Napanee was the last Dominion candidate. H.B. Sherwood is talked of as a good candidate and appears willing. He was managing "The Bay of Quinte" R.R. "which has been taken over by the Canadian Northern R.R. He came from the United States and is naturalized.
