Sir,-

Referring to your requisition for the present month, I am returning herewith the declarations as to settlement duties, for amendment, as they do not show whether the clearing on lots 9 and 10, Range 1, Temisamingue Indian Reserve, has been fenced, as required by the Regulations of the Department. I have also to point out that the declarations show ten acres as having been cleared, but as the regulations require that five acres in every hundred acres included in the sale should be cleared, it will be necessary for the applicant for patent to clear and fence at least 11 acres before patent can issue, *as the sale covers 211.67 acres.*
