



Sir,-

With further reference to our letter of the 29th November last and yours of the 2nd ultimo (your file No. 10131 ) regarding the confirmation of a reserve on the west shore of Lake St. Martin, heretofore designated as the Lake St. Martin Indian Reserve No. 44; I beg to say that it has been decided to change the name to the Little Saskatchewan Indian Reserve No. 45, as there is now another reserve on Lake St. Martin. You are requested to use the new designation in the application for confirmation of this reserve.
