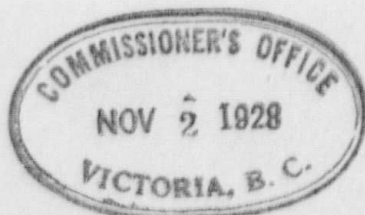
I recently returned from an extended trip up the Nass. Many of the Indians at Kincolith are still away at their hunting and fishing camps. It would therefore, be advisable to defer my visit regarding the matter of the damaged timber until they are all back which will be about the end of November, and unless I hear from you to the contrary I shall conclude that you are agreeable.
