

which terminates along the left bank of Thompson River, and
immediately north of the Town of Lytton.

* 10 inches of water from the above claim
from Lytton Creek or any other available
source of water supply, and all the water
in the two springs between the West boundary
of the Reserve and the left bank of the
Thompson River.

On the left bank of Thompson River, below
the Gate-Cariboo Highway, about a mile
from Lytton, known to the Indians as *Wap-tan*,
* 8 inches of water for irrigation and other
purposes from any available source of
water supply.

On the right bank of the Thompson River, off
the main road, about a mile from Lytton,
* 8 inches of water from the *Wap-tan*
stream for irrigation and other purposes.

A Reserve on the right bank of Thompson
River in the angle formed by said right bank
and the left bank of the *Wap-tan* stream, and
near the mouth of the latter.

* 8 inches of water from the *Wap-tan* stream
or from any other source of water supply.

Situated about 10 miles west from
Lytton on the West Coast trail.

* 200 inches of water from any available
source of water supply.

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
