No person under the age of eighteen shall be admitted to membership.

Sec. 7. The Local shall collect from its memhers a monthly tax of at least ten cents, which shall he receipted for hy stamps purchased from the Provincial Executive Committee, or where no Provincial Executive Committee exists from the Dominion Executive Committee, at ten cents each, and in no other manner. The Secretary shall affix stamps to member's card, and cancel same hy writing amount paid across face of stamp in ink over his initials.

No discrimination shall be made as to monthly tax or assessments, except as provided in Section 8, Article II.

Sec. 8. Members who have withheld payment of dues for more than two months shall be suspended from all rights until they have fulfilled their obligations. To reinstate themselves by such payment of such hack dues they must first obtain permission from a regular business meeting of the Local. Sick or unemployed members may be excused from payment of dues upon application to a regular business meeting of the Local.

Sec. 9. Any direct violation of the pledge of memhership or of party law shall be considered warrant for suspension or expulsion, notice of
