CHAPTER VI

ADVERBS

An adverb should be placed near the word it modifies. Generally, it follows the verb in its simple tenses, and is placed between the auxiliary and the verb in compound tenses.

Ex. : *Ils ont bien parlé,*

They have well spoken.

He works slowly,

Il travaille lentement.
