CHAP. I.

Whereas, in compliance with the requirements of the 9th Victoria, chapter 40, it is necessary that the Municipal Council of the District of Huron do appoint a fit and proper person to act as treasurer of the district, Be it enacted by the temporary Chairman and Municipal Council of the said district, in pursuance of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, passed in the 9th year of her present Majesty's reign, entitled "An Act to amend the Laws relative to "District Councils in Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That George Brown, junior, Esq., of Goderich, in the said district, be and is hereby declared to be the treasurer of the said district, for the term and with the powers vested in the treasurer by the 7th section of the said Act 9th Victoria, chapter 40.
