

CHAP. 55.

An Act to provide for Old Age Assistance.

[Assented to 30th June, 1951.]

IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as The Old Age Assistance Act.
