VICTIMS OF NIAGARA.

Body of an Unknown Man Found—A Workman Drowned.

GENERAL NEWS OF CANADA.

Proposed Milling Changes—Young Man Drowned at Peterboro'—Railroad Employee Crushed to Death—Big Ship in Ontario—Other Items.

NIAGARA FALLS, Aug. 14.—Saturday afternoon one of the crew of the new M. J. of the Mill saw a body floating face down in the gorge below the Falls. An attempt was made to get the body, but it floated into an eddy on the Canadian side where it could be reached.

Mrs. William Glasscock, of the Mill of the Mill, got a small child and secured the body, which was towed to the Canadian wharf by the steamer.

The body appeared to be that of a man about 20 years of age and about 5 feet 10 inches in height. It was entirely nude and had the appearance of having been in the water for some time. The back was numerous bruises and the scalp was nearly torn from the head.

The body was in a bad state of decomposition, and will have to be buried immediately.

Undertaker Morse, of Drummondville, was notified and had the remains moved to the morgue.

OTTAWA'S BLAZE

OTTAWA, Aug. 14.—A destructive fire broke out shortly before 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon in the rear of J. B. Abbott's carriage factory, Wellington street, right in the Chandler lumber yard, in which time about \$80,000 worth of damage was done. The fire originated in a three-story wooden building in the rear of the carriage factory, Wellington and Bay streets, and swept the whole of the rear of the block 225 feet long, and the fire worked its way through to Wellington street, and for a while it looked as if the whole block would go, but that this did not happen. Several times the buildings on the south side of Wellington street caught fire, but were promptly put out by the firemen, who worked splendidly, fighting the fire not only with skill and skill, but with excellent judgment. Only one house, that at the west end of the block, occupied by J. Latremont, entirely destroyed, and the adjoining house, occupied by T. Ferguson, and B. Harvan, was gutted. The stores with residences of J. E. Grant, Jeweler, and C. W. Willmot, lapidary, were slightly damaged. Mr. Abbott lost two horses and a large quantity of stock in the rear building, but his factory proper, which is a solid brick building, was not damaged. He estimates his loss at \$15,000, on which there is about \$10,000 insurance. Latremont's loss is about \$10,000, on which there is no insurance.

While this fire was at its height the fire alarm whistle in Eddy's mill across the river in Hull sounded, and it was thought his factory was again downed. It turned out, however, that the fire was in a pile of lumber in the mill, and although it burnt until midnight and destroyed 2,000 cords of lumber it did not spread to any of the buildings.
