

WOULD LIMIT DUTIES OF CROWN ATTORNEY

Dr. Stevenson Declares Petition Demands Legislation.

Several of London's representative lawyers have urged Dr. Hugh Stevenson, M. L. A., he declared Monday, that he present a petition to Attorney-General Flanagan, asking that crown attorneys and police magistrates in Ontario be prohibited from practicing their profession in addition to performing duties of state. The member for London asserts that he is quite willing to bring this question before the attorney-general as soon as possible.

Dr. Stevenson declares that the lawyers of the city are circulating a petition among their colleagues of the bar asking that the present fee system be abolished for court officials, including the crown attorney. While the latter engages in private activities, they claim, he transacts considerable business for the police magistrates of the district, while the latter in turn direct many clients to his office for legal advice who might ordinarily go elsewhere.

It is held that the Ontario Government should employ attorneys, who would be prohibited from engaging in other than court business, with the result that many disadvantages would be overcome and the public would benefit greatly. That a straight salary of \$8,000 or \$7,000 a year would attract a capable man is the contention, while incidentally, it is pointed out, with the fee system abolished, there would be no inducement to send clients to the crown attorney's office.

It is added further that the police magistrate also should devote his time to nothing but court affairs.

"There are only two centers in the province," declares Dr. Stevenson, "are the magistrate conducts his private affairs in addition to his duties on the bench. These cities are London and Toronto. Special legislation was enacted many years ago to make this possible."

URGES LONDON TO OPPOSE INCREASE

City Is Asked To Fight Higher Telephone Rates.

The city of London is being asked to again join in the fight against the Bell Telephone Company for increased rates.

However, if London goes in with the large centers for the fight, it will find its rates fixed on the same basis as the large centers. The city council will likely deal with the matter Monday night.

MANY GARAGES ARE BEING CONSTRUCTED

Majority of Building Permits Are For Auto Shelters.

If every new garage being erected in the city means a new auto, it can be safely concluded that the dearth of money, at present fairly general, is not a very serious matter.

So far for this month the building inspector has issued ten building permits, and of these seven are for garages. During the month of September, of the 118 permits issued, two were for garages. Total figures of the number of garages erected so far this year are not available.

CITY EMPLOYEES TO BE FIRED AND HIRED AGAIN

In less than two weeks the full force of workers on municipal improvements will be dismissed and hired again under a new agreement. This is a scheme devised to care for the city's unemployed during the coming winter.

Before the new force will be taken on the application of every man, woman and child, the applicant must fill out a card, giving full details about himself. In this way, the city hopes to be able to care for its own unemployed, giving married men the first call, and then the single men.

Chairman Watson of the finance committee is giving much attention to the matter. He stated that there are many people who have the idea that the city's scheme will apply to all families, and that they can get a job with the city during the winter, a man must have been on the city's force for at least six months.
