

METEOROLOGICAL OFFICE, Toronto, Nov. 15, 1 a.m.—An area of low pressure, which has developed since last night, is now situated over Wisconsin, and the pressure is high in the western states and about the Atlantic cost. The weather has been generally fine and comparatively mild in all portions of Canada. The south cone has been ordered up for the Georgian bay and Lake Huron. Probabilities—Lakes, southeast to south-west and west winds, increasing to strong breezes or moderate gales in some localities; generally cloudy, mild weather, with light rains.
