## WHAT A SILVER BASIS MEANS.

It is estimated that the defeat of the resolution in the House of Representatives authorizing the President to negotiate bonds specifically payable in gold has cost the United States \$16,000,000. The vote, which was 167 to 120, was not divided on party lines. The Democrats were divided about equally. Of the Republicans, 63 voted against the resolution and 31 for it. The Populists voted solidly against it. The vote shows us how strongly the tide is moving in favor of reducing the national finances to a silver basis. The future monetary standard of the country is now the greatest problem before the States have to solve. The silver party appear to be getting stronger all the while, and it is not at all improbable that they may finally be able to force the restoration of a silver basis. What effect such a restoration would have upon the country is the subject of a great diversity of opinion between the people of the Eastern States on the one hand, and those of the South and West on the other. The Standard, one of the leading financial journals of Great Britain, expresses this opinion:

"If gold is demonetized, it is perfectly clear there will be a great transfer of property from the capitalists and lending classes to the producing and borrowing classes. This would be of immense advantage to the west and south, and would prove a serious loss to the Eastern States and to Europe. The great reduction of debts all over the United States by a fall to silver would give the farming and producing classes generally a sense of freedom and prosperity which they have not had for many years, and would probably give a great stimulus to production. If silver did not rise much for a while, American wheat, cotton, pork, etc., would compete with the produce of other countries at a very great advantage, and there would be probably a very rapid and great growth of exports, and at the beginning an era of great prosperity. On the other hand the lending and creditor classes would suffer, but their losses would not affect production to anything like the same extent as the gains of the debtors and producers would do. Further, there would be a very serious fall in securities, which would injure capitalists and lenders, both in the United States and in Europe."

The Eastern view is thus summarized by The New York Evening Post, whose editor, Mr. Horace White, is considered one of the ablest champions of gold monometallism in the United States:

"Suppose the wreckers and repudiators could have their way and get the country on silver, they would be as far as the laws are concerned, who would be hurt? Not one of the men whom they want to hurt. The great importing and jobbing houses of the eastern cities would not lose a penny. Most of them already, in their contracts for future delivery of goods, insert a clause calling for payment in gold, or its equivalent in currency, and the rest of them would only have to buy a rubber stamp put in it in their contracts, too. The gold clause we understand, has been put in all considerable mortgages taken in this part of the country ever since the Republic began to play the silver game. Stewart and the silver-loving Californians have no monopoly of the gold clause in mortgages. Every mortgage without it would be foreclosed instantly, the western borrowers would find out to their cost. The old troublesome system of two accounts at the bank, one in gold and one in currency, would have to be returned to, but as far as getting the business of this country off the gold basis is concerned, it cannot be done, law or no law. Wages might be cut for two or three weeks, but it would not be possible to touch the standard of value established for all the great imports and exports, and the silver-loving Californians distributing and banking business of this country. That standard is established by the laws of business and civilization itself, and they are beyond repeal by any Congress. The sooner the silver-loving repudiators get this into their heads the sooner will they quit fighting the stars in their courses."

## WINTER NAVIGATION ON THE LAKE.

Winter navigation on the lake is attracting more and more attention, and enthusiastic mariners say the time is not far off when commerce will be carried on in winter on the great lakes much the same as it is upon the ocean. For some years there have been several lines of boats operating on Lake Michigan, and others are now projected. One of the latest proposals is that seriously entertained by the general manager of one of the Michigan railways. He is planning to send sleeping cars straight from Toledo to St. Paul by having them carried across Lake Michigan on cat ferries. It will no doubt be quite feasible to transport the cars across the lake winter and summer, as the ferry service between Mackinac city and St. Ignace, where winter navigation is more difficult than at any other point, is now working with the greatest of satisfaction. The ferry service there has never yet met ice through which it could not plow. This winter a new route has been opened between Milwaukee and Muskegon, and several Milwaukee brewing companies are contemplating the construction of ferries for an all-year service between that city and South Chicago. Of the projected routes the most interesting to us is the one which will establish winter navigation on Lake Erie. Ferries similar to that at the Ann Arbor line are under construction at Toledo for use in the Ohio-Canadian service. The projectors intend them to transport supplies across the lake to Ohio and to take back coal for Canadian consumers, thus doing away with a long detour around the end of the lake. The Pittsburgh, Chenango and Lake Erie Railroad last fall adopted the Ann Arbor plan of car ferries in order to make direct connections from Cleveland to the Grand Trunk system at Port Dover.

Two immense ferries for this service will be in operation next fall. They are much larger than the Ann Arbor boats. The latter are 285 feet over all and 63 feet beam, whereas the Connaught ferries will be 350 feet long and 56 feet beam, and will carry 30 loaded cars at a single trip. They will be of steel, with wooden upper works. The Ann Arbor boats are open above, the main deck, where the cars are loaded, but the Lake Erie ferries will be housed in like any steamer, large doors being provided at the stern to be closed in after the cars have been taken aboard. They will make a run of about 50 miles from port to port.

## SHOULD BE A REGULATED MONOPOLY.

It is to be hoped the city will obtain full power from the Legislature to control of the traffic between the city and the Island. The ferry business between these points can be operated most economically for those engaged in it, and most advantageously for the public, by leasing it to a regulated monopoly. We don't want the business in the hands of rival companies. Competition involves largely increased expense, and we may rest assured the people will have to foot the bill whether the service is conducted expensively or economically. There is another consideration, in addition to that of expense. An unnecessarily large number of boats, operated by rival companies, in the limited waters of the bay renders a trip to the Island a source of danger. Last season there was a collision between two of the rival boats, and two or three hundred people narrowly escaped drowning. Our representatives will not be doing the city's business properly if they do not perfect arrangements at once and have the ferry business operated by a single company during the coming season. The sale of the street railway franchise should form a basis for the sale of the Island ferry franchise. Proscriptions, certain time-table and fix the price of tickets, and then sell the franchise to the company that will give the largest percentage of gross receipts.

## THE INTERNATIONAL WATERWAY.

The Engineering News says: "A ship canal to connect the Great Lakes, St. Lawrence and the Hudson River is proposed in a bill soon to be presented to Congress, incorporating the Maritime Canal Company of North America, with a capital stock of \$10,000,000 in \$10 shares, while the company may have an interest-bearing debt of \$200,000,000. The Government may at any time assume possession of the canals and works by giving the company one week's notice and paying for them a sum to be fixed by three arbitrators. A charter has already been obtained in Canada."

## A sign of the times is the news from Chicago to the effect that Mayor Hopkins is going east to raise a loan of from twenty to fifty millions, to be used in improving the city's gas and electric supply and street transit. The idea is to place all these enterprises under city control.

## Canadian Tweeds.

Editor World: I notice in reading your editorial in The World of to-day on the bicycle question, that you mention Canadian tweeds. I am sorry to inform you that you are very far astray. If you take the trouble to go through our large wholesale warehouses and enquire to whom do they sell their Canadian woollens, you will find that it is to the manufacturer of clothing to whom they are sold, not the merchant tailor. Ten years ago, when I was in the business, we bought many Canadian tweeds, but found they did not hold their color, and every year since then we have been buying less, and more imported goods. I am sure we only make in the same line of business as you, and I am sure you will not set me down as a free trader. I am a believer in protection, but could not let you make such a statement without correcting you.

## East York Pleowmen.

## Over the Bon.

Yesterday at 8.20 a.m. the men from Bolton-avenue, who had been on fire in the manufacturing premises occupied by Harris & Co., 420 Pape-avenue, as follows: John Harris, 400 gallons of tallow and 180 barrels of refined tallow were stored on the premises, which the firemen, with great trouble, succeeded in saving. The damage exceeded \$250, which is covered by insurance. Only four minutes elapsed from the time the alarm reached Bolton-avenue until the firemen were at the blaze.

## Rev. J. Scott Howard, M.A., preached a special sermon yesterday morning at St. Matthew's church on behalf of the ocean missions. In the course of an earnest address the preacher pointed out that the diocese of Toronto is the third largest in the world, those of Madras and Calcutta alone exceeding it.
