I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note No. 24 of August 18, 1958 in which you propose certain amendments to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Canada for services between and beyond their respective territories which was signed at Ottawa on August 19, 1949.

The Canadian Government accepts the proposals and agrees that your Note No. 24 of August 18, 1958 and this reply thereto shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter, to take effect immediately.
