Agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1

1. The Governments signatories to this Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the "Contracting Parties", have agreed to terminate the Telegraph Agreements entered into pursuant to the provisions of clause 6 of the Commonwealth Telegraph Agreement signed at London on 25 July 1948 and the Telegraph Agreements signed at London on 25 July 1948 and 23 July 1948.

ARTICLE 2

2. Accounts in respect of the period prior to the entry into force of this Agreement which have not been settled under the Telegraph Agreement entered into pursuant to clause 6 of the Commonwealth Telegraph Agreement 1948 shall, as soon as possible after entry into force of this Agreement, be made up by the National Bodies of the Contracting Parties to this Agreement and settled between them as nearly as may be in accordance with the provisions of the said Agreement entered into pursuant to clause 6 of the Commonwealth Telegraph Agreement 1948.

ARTICLE 3

3. The costs of any pension or gratuity payable or which may become payable to any person in respect of his employment with the former Commonwealth Telecommunications Board or with the Commonwealth Telecommunications Bureau and of any pension or gratuity payable to any dependant of any such person and any increase in such pensions or gratuities as may from time to time be agreed by the Commonwealth Telecommunications Council shall, in the same proportions as the Governments Parties to this Agreement contribute to the expenses of the Commonwealth Telecommunications Council, be paid to the Commonwealth Telecommunications Bureau for disbursement by the Bureau to the persons to whom any such pension or gratuity is payable.

ARTICLE 4

4. By their acceptance of this Agreement the Governments Parties hereto accept it on their own behalf and on behalf of their National Bodies and in respect of the territories for the international relations of which any such Government is responsible.
